

Acceptable Photo Identification and Social Security Number Documents

Prior to the 341 meeting all debtors must submit to the trustee: (1) a copy of their original government-issued photo Identification (ID) and (2) confirmation of their Social Security number (SSN) or Individual Tax Identification number (ITIN). Acceptable forms of photo ID and proof of SSN are listed below.

ACCEPTABLE PHOTO IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS

- Driver's license
- U.S. government ID
- State ID
- Student ID
- Passport of current visa, if not a U.S. citizen
- Military ID
- Resident alien card
- Identity card issued by a national government authority

ACCEPTABLE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER DOCUMENTS

- Social Security card
- Medical insurance card
- Pay stub
- W-2 form
- IRS Form 1099
- Social Security Administration statement
- ITIN (only if debtor is not eligible for a SSN)

Please note that tax returns are **NOT** acceptable proof of an SSN.

TAX RETURNS THAT ARE **NOT** ACCEPTABLE

- Account Transcript
- Wage and Income Transcript
- W-2 Transcript

PAY ADVICE INFORMATION NEEDED


Must be within 60 days from the time the case was filed
